With a focus on what connects us to each other and to our environment, the book presents perspectives, statements, knowledge and research from contributors with a diverse range of backgrounds. Together, they form a diverse field of interacting insights from philosophy, science and cultural theory to poetry, activism and the arts. Each in their way, they address overlapping phenomena, and together, they invite the reader to reflect on our life on this planet.
